

Bubble Wrap Art w/Paint

Supplies

- Watercolor Paper
- Watercolor Paints
- Flat head toothbrush(s)
- Paint brush(s) for watercolors
- Paper plates
- Wide and shallow bowls or cups
- Bubble wrap
- Cup of water



Instructions

Paint the tree first:

1. Choose a paint color for your tree and squeeze a small amount onto the plate
2. Gently dip the brush head of the tooth brush into the paint and brush up on the paper to create the tree trunk.
 - a. Using the tip of the tooth brush, create tree branches (use as little or as much paint as you want).

TIP:

- Don't make the tree too big on the paper. Remember that we still need to add the leaves.
- You may want to add a little of the tree color to the bottom of the page to create the ground.

Painting the leaves:

1. Choose at least 2 different colors and squeeze a small amount of each into separate shallow bowls.
2. Take a wet paintbrush and mix one color so that you've made a wider amount of paint.
3. Bunch up some bubble wrap and gently dip it into the wider amount of paint.
4. Now start to add your leaves by using the bubble wrap as your paint brush by touching the paper in a dotting fashion.
5. Do the same with the other paint color.

TIP:

- Make sure the leaves look like they are coming off each branch.
- 6. You can now add more colors or more branches(using the tooth brush tip or the paint brush).
