Watercolor Blend Bookmarks



What's in the kit:

- Mini Paint Circle Palettes (2)
- Watercolor Bookmark Template (2)
- Q-tips (3)
- Thin yarn

What you'll need:

- Cup of warm water
- Paper towel
- Pencil
- Teaspoon of salt

Instructions:

1. Start by adding water to fill the reservoir of the mini paint circle palette.
 - a. Let the water dissolve the paint.
 - b. Gently stir the paint/water mixture with a Q-tip.
 - c. Repeat the process with the other mini paint circle palette, using the **clean end** of the same Q-tip.

OPTIONAL: Create a wet base by using a clean Q-tip to "paint" water across the bookmark template.

OPTIONAL: Use the pencil to create a light design first, then paint it in with the Q-tip!
2. While the bookmark is wet, apply paint in any pattern you like using your remaining Q-tips.

TIP: Experiment with blending; add interesting visual elements by sprinkling salt on the paper.
3. Once your bookmark is dry, string the thin yard through the precut hole and tie the yarn.

Flatten your new bookmark by placing it in a closed book.

Now start using your new bookmark with your next read!!!
